## What are the biggest challenges for you at sea?

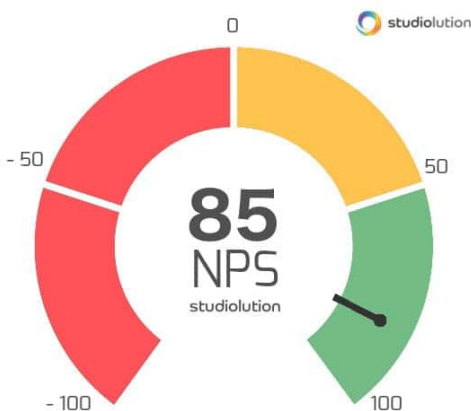
“Bad weather, rough sea, unfriendly Co workers”
